Responsibilities Include:

- Communications with job site representative & CES Calgary.
- Driving from base location to one or more job sites, then return back to home base daily, or in 14-21 day cycles.
- Access each job site by vehicle and report to job site representative.
- Access drilling rig and area by foot to collect data and fluid samples.
- Carry, handle & set up drilling fluid equipment to analyze fluid properties.
- Report all information collected on a formal document, distribute copies to all required personal by paper and electronic files.
- Inspect all drilling fluid products and storage conditions.
- Document all HSE required reports, Inventory Dry/Liquid counts.

Secondary Duties Include:

- 24 hour site observation during problematic scenarios on the job site. (Well Control, Loss Of Circulation, Fluid Contamination, Stuck Drill Pipe).
- Inventory reconciliation with job site representative.
- Site observation for loading drilling fluid products from warehouse to site or Vice Versa.

Qualifications Include:

- Prior experience on active drilling sites is required.
- Excellent communication skills, both written and verbal.
- Solids control experience is an asset but not required.
- Prior to beginning work, the candidate must have completed H2S Alive, Standard First Aid and WHMIS training.
- A valid class 5 driver's licence or equivalent is also required.
- Legally able to work in Canada.
