- Brief passengers on flight information and details
- Complete all post flight duties, including notification/confirmation to company of the whereabouts of the aircraft when away, recording flight times and any defects, etc.
- Responsible for ensuring that the required IFR/VFR charts, maps, etc., are on the aircraft as required for the flight
- Responsible for using the checklists provided in the aircraft
- Actively supports the company Safety Policies by participating in the program and acting appropriately for their role
- All other duties assigned
